Participants should be the members of organization, nonformal groups working with youth or volunteers, and youth work coordinator or member of local or regional government. We ask partners to choose, prepare and support participants during the whole duration of the project, including the follow-up.

In a beautiful town with rich history – Trenčín, in Slovakia. Participants will be accommodated at Pension Branecy in the middle of town. 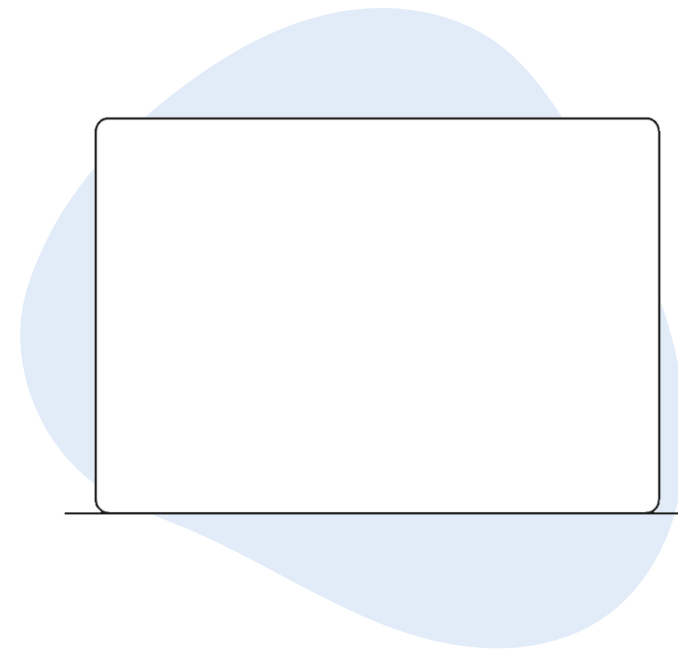

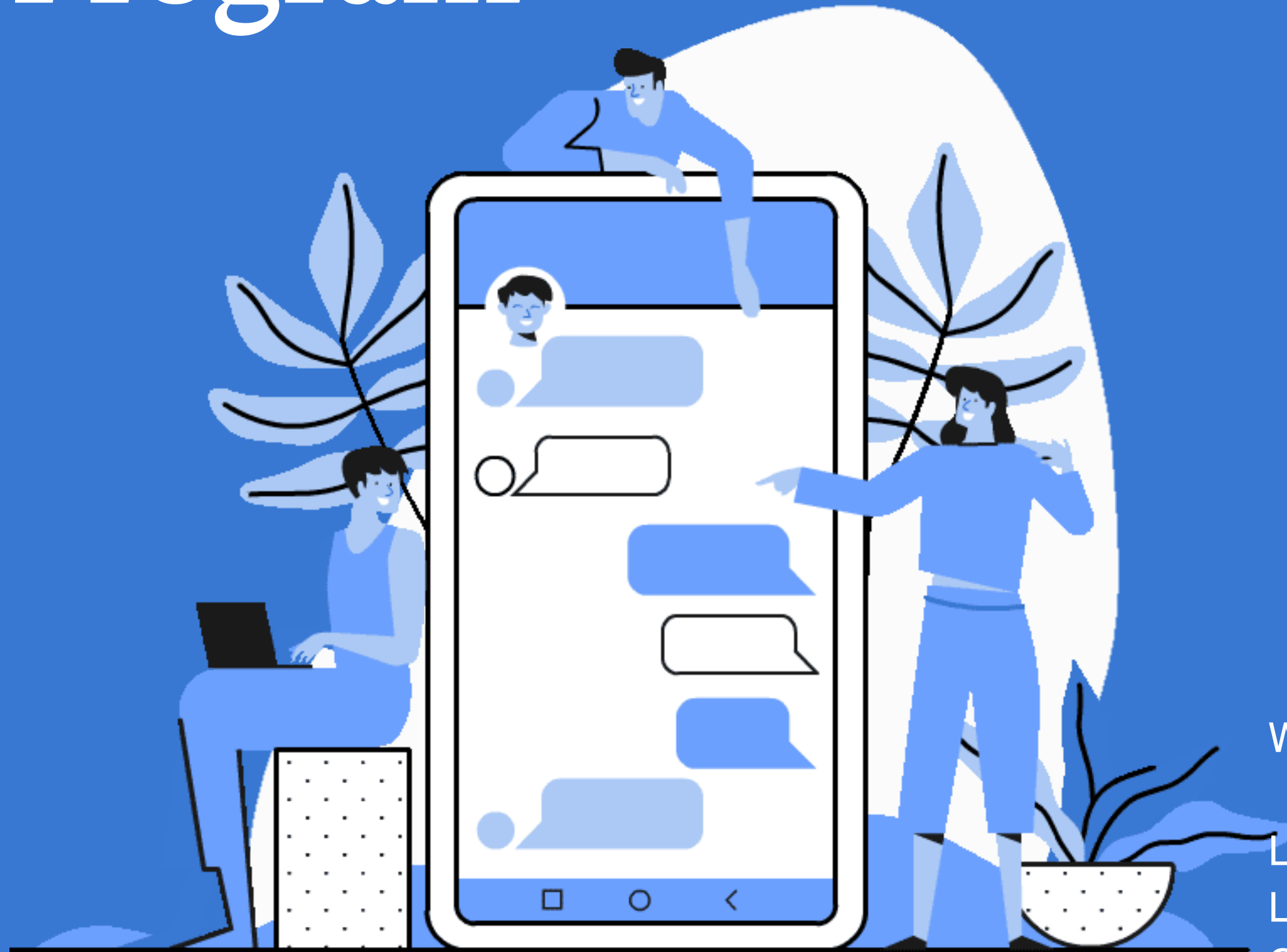
